The Skate Saskatoon Summer School is looking forward to another great summer season. The school is proud of the programs offered, at the most reasonable and affordable rates. From young skaters passing their first Preliminary test or landing their first axel to the highest competitive skaters competing internationally and at the Canadian Championships, the school has seen many young dedicated athletes reach their personal goals. We strive to keep that tradition going. We look forward to having you join the school and know it will be a rewarding experience.

Due to the July 1st holiday falling in the middle of what would traditionally be our first week of summer school, the school has been shortened to six weeks. However, the June Ice Time program has been lengthened to include June 28th, 29th, 30th, and July 2nd. The sessions will be open to all levels and fees are on a per-session basis. This year a former international competitor and Saskatchewan Provincial team member, Jamie Britton, will be available for partnering during the final week of the school. Jamie partners all dances including the diamond dances. Check the coaching section of our brochure.

Read the brochure carefully and select the programs and sessions that suit your needs. For those attending for the first time, your coach can assist you in filling out your application. Both sides of the application form must be filled out and sent back as soon as possible. Skaters should register for sessions they feel are most appropriate to their training level. If this is not possible, feel free to phone the School for any clarification. Once the School receives your application, confirmation will be emailed. Any problems or concerns will be noted at that time. **Receipts and all pertinent information will be sent by email. Please make sure you indicate your most frequently used email address on the application form. Final confirmations of skating times and group placements will be sent after the early registration date in June.**

To help with administration and to get information to coaches we ask that skaters register by June 15th. Due to the additional administration involved with applications received after this date an increased administration fee has to be charged. **Skaters can still register any time until the last week of the school but it could be difficult securing preferred ice time and coaching. Skaters may register for one to six weeks.**

Skaters 12 years and older may apply to work as a Music Player during the Summer School. Information will be included on our website (www.skatesaskatoon.com). **MUSIC PLAYER APPLICATIONS MUST BE RETURNED TO THE SCHOOL BY JUNE 15th**

The ACT Center boasts two large ice surfaces with dressing rooms and locker facilities for everyone. Skaters also have access to video and a jump training harness. The rink has a concession and a skater's lounge to eat meals and socialize. Skate sharpening is available.

The ACT skating rink is on a major bus route from the city center and is surrounded by excellent accommodation. Adjacent to the rink complex are four tennis courts. There are many convenience stores within blocks of the complex. The University of Saskatchewan is only five minutes away, providing many parents with the opportunity to take summer classes.

The city of Saskatoon is a wonderful place to be in the summer. There are great golf courses and indoor and outdoor swimming pools. There are numerous places of interest, parks, theaters, galleries, and museums, most notably the Western Development Museum. The Pike Lake and Blackstrap Provincial Parks as well as the Beaver Creek Conservation Area and Wanuskewin Heritage Park are all within one-hour drives from the city. CANCELLATION & REFUND POLICY: Any refund requests after June 15th in regards to cancellation of booked skating times and programs must be requested in the form of a letter sent to SkateSaskatoon. In the case of an injury the letter must be accompanied by a doctor's certificate. An administration fee will be applied to all refunds and will be calculated on a case-by-case basis. All refund requests must be made by August 15th.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

TEST DAYS – Test day scheduling will be determined by judges' availability. Skaters should book their summer skating to include the test day at their level.

July 23 – up to and including Gold Freeskate, Skills, Dance, Competitive Singles

Aug. 13 – up to and including Gold Freeskate, Skills, Dance, Competitive Singles

Pair and Diamond dance tests are offered at the discretion of Skate Saskatoon. Those wishing to take these tests must request them **in writing** through the test chairperson prior to the start of summer school on July 5th. Your confirmation in June will include any changes to the tests available as stated above. **Test days and times are dependant on judge availability.** TEST FEES WILL BE POSTED AT THE RINK AND MUST BE PAID BEFORE TESTS CAN BE TAKEN.

OFF-ICE PROGRAM – This year Skate Saskatoon Summer School will provide an off-ice program for Groups A, B, C, D, and E. The goal of the program is to address the athlete's needs in the areas of co-ordination, endurance and flexibility as well as improving artistic presentation. Incorporated within the group training will be instructor-led session(s) set to uplifting music incorporating different forms of exercise training and dance.

The training will be developed and supervised by Alex Simon. Alex has represented Saskatchewan at the Canada Winter Games, Junior Nationals and the Canadian Championships. She was the former Junior Ladies Champion of Saskatchewan. Alex has extensive training in ballet (10 years) and jazz and has worked with many well-known exercise specialists. We are very pleased to have Alex on our staff as she brings a fresh new dynamic to our off-ice training program.

The Off- Ice Program is separated into four 45 minute sessions per week, on Mondays, Tuesdays and Wednesdays, and Thursdays, upstairs at the A.C.T. Centre.

Group times for skaters will be allotted according to freeskate levels as well as age and length of registered skating time at the School; the lowest level will start at Group A and continue up Group E and Competitive level. Dance and skills music will be played for all necessary levels in the group time. Freeskate sessions will have a limited number of skaters on the ice. Group Preference should be indicated on the application form. Final group placement and requested changes will be at the discretion of the summer school. Our goal is to group skaters so that everyone on is able to skate in a safe environment and to train as unrestricted as possible.

SUMMER SCHOOL FEES

To be a registered participant of the Skate Saskatoon Summer School, a skater must register in the Full Group Program, Half Group Program or Alternate Program. An explanation of these programs follows. The skater's choice is to be indicated on the application form. Skaters may register for any number of weeks and may start on any Monday, which also must be indicated on the form. This would be considered your week # 1. **After receiving all the applications, appropriate times will be allotted to each skater and these times will be sent by email with your confirmation in early June.** Any changes to these conditions must be requested in a letter with your application and must get approval from the club manager. The school is very flexible about arranging skating times to fit individual needs.

1. FULL GROUP PROGRAM - This entitles the skater to **one** skills session, **one** spin session, **one** dance session and **two** freeskate sessions during an appropriate group time, as indicated on the skating schedule. Freeskate sessions may be substituted for skills and dance times. Changes should be indicated on the application form. Monday to Friday.

2. HALF GROUP PROGRAM - This entitles the skater to **one** skills session, **one** spin session, **one** freeskate session and **one** dance session during an appropriate group time. Freeskate sessions may be substituted for skills and dance times. Changes should be indicated on the application form. Monday to Friday.

3. EXTRA SESSIONS - Extra sessions are offered for registered summer school skaters in the Full or Half Group Program who feel they would like additional sessions to what is offered in the Group programs as well as for dance and pair teams. Skaters may register for any number of extra sessions chosen from those indicated in the skating schedule. All extra time will be allotted in accordance with the skater's schedule. Indicate any extra session times on the application form with the appropriate fee for the number of extra sessions booked and the # of weeks. Those who wish to substitute extra sessions for group times must get approval from the School. In some cases extra times are allocated to skaters when group times are full. Competitive sessions are limited.

4. ALTERNATE PROGRAM – This program is offered to skaters wishing to register in only 1 or 2 daily sessions per week. This would be beneficial to Group A skaters, especially those who are new to Summer school. Please indicate session times wanted on the application form.
